

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Koji Yoneda, a citizen of Japan, residing at c/o Seiko Precision Inc. 1-1, Akanehama 1-chome, Narashino-shi, Chiba-ken, Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the Assignor") has invented certain new and useful improvements in an ELECTROLUMINESCENT ELEMENT, Serial No. 09/267,812 for which an application for United States Letters Patent is executed herewith and was filed on March 12, 1999 and

Assignor hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent on the aforesaid invention or resulting from the aforesaid application directly to the Assignee.

Assignor hereby authorize the Assignee and its successors to apply for a patent or patents directly in its own name upon the aforesaid invention wherever the same is permitted by law, and also assign, sell, transfer and set over unto the Assignee and its successors all priority rights under the aforesaid application.

Assignor further covenant to execute all additional instruments and to do all things necessary to carry out the purpose of this instrument, at the expense of the Assignee and its successors.
