



WHEREAS, I, James A. McEwan of 14 Longroyde Grove, Rastrick, Brighouse, West Yorkshire SD6 3US, UK has an invention entitled:

TURBOCHARGER WITH WASTEGATE ACTUATOR


I HEREBY AUTHORIZE Assignees to insert in this assignment document the filing date and serial number of the application if the date and number are unavailable at the time this document is executed.
