

**CONFIRMATION OF ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS**

**WHEREAS:**


- A. Gordon Loewen and Llana Belle Loewen, both of 12788 Jack Bell Drive, Richmond, British Columbia, Canada V6V 2T2 are the inventors of certain inventions or improvements as described and claimed in the patents and patent applications particularized in the attached Schedule "A".
- B. Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement made as of the 31st day of July, 1996 certain rights in the said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications were acquired by Gorlan Fairing Inc., a British Columbia company (hereafter, the said Gordon Loewen, Llana Belle Loewen and Gorlan Fairing Inc. are collectively called the "Assignors") having an office at Suite 16 - 12240 Horseshoe Way, Richmond, British Columbia, Canada V7A 4X9.
- C. Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated for reference August 1, 1997 and made as of October 23, 1997 certain rights in the said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications were acquired by Gorlan Trailer Fairing (Barbados) Inc., a Barbados company (hereafter the "Assignee") having its registered office at Chancery House, High Street, Bridgetown, Barbados.
- D. It is desired, by this memorandum, to confirm the transactions aforesaid and to provide evidence thereof in a form suitable for recordal in such Patent Offices as may be expedient, so as to vest in the Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to the said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications and in, to and under any and all Letters Patent which may be granted on or as a result of the said patent applications.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, WE, the Assignors, do hereby, both jointly and severally, confirm that we have and do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to the Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to the said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications and any and all continuations, divisions, renewals of or substitutes for said applications, and in, to and under any and all Letters Patent which may be granted on or as a result thereof, and any reissue or reissues of said Letters Patent; and WE assign to and authorize the Assignee to file in our names applications for Letters Patent for said inventions or improvements in all countries, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives, to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent respectively may be granted, reissued or extended, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by us, had this assignment, sale and transfer not been made;

AND WE hereby covenant that WE have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that WE have not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith, and WE further covenant and agree that WE will, each time request is made and without undue delay, execute and deliver all such papers as may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications in the Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives, and WE agree to communicate to the Assignee, or its nominees, all known facts respecting said inventions, improvements, patents and patent applications, to testify in any legal proceedings, to sign all lawful papers, to execute all disclaimers and divisional, continuing, reissue and foreign applications, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid the Assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees and legal representatives to obtain and enforce for its or their own benefit, proper patent protection for said inventions or improvements in any and all countries, all at the expense, however, of the Assignee or its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives;

AND WE hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States of America whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue to the Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest, any and all Letters Patent for said inventions or improvements, which may be issued and granted on or as a result of the application aforesaid, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.


