23 to such applications and Letters Patent.

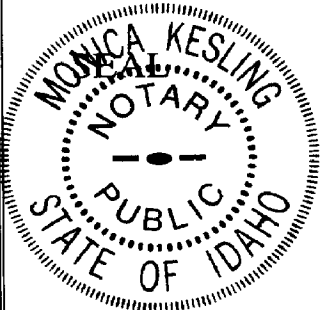

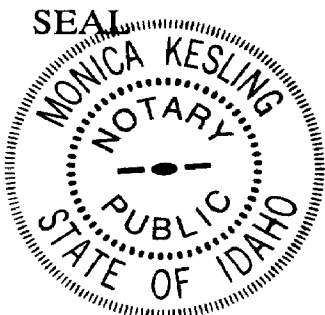
