

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

THIS AGREEMENT is made by Jack M. Schooley of Vancouver, Washington (hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOLEY") and Jason R. CROWE of Vancouver, Washington (hereinafter referred to as "CROWE").

WHEREAS, SCHOOLEY has made certain invention relating to CLAMP FOR SECURING A RULER TO A GUIDE for which he is about to file an application for Letters Patent of the United States; and

WHEREAS, SCHOOLEY has agreed to assign an undivided interest in, to and under said invention, said application including any divisional or continuation thereof, and any Letters Patent of the United States to be obtained therefor (including any reissue thereof) (hereinafter referred to as "the Property") to CROWE, while retaining for himself an undivided interest in, to and under the Property.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, SCHOOLEY hereby sells, assigns and transfers to CROWE an undivided forty-nine percent (49%) interest in, to and under the Property, while retaining for himself the remaining undivided fifty-one percent (51%) interest in, to and under the Property.

IN ADDITION, the parties hereto agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. All net profits and income received from the exploitation of the Property, whether the net profits and income are in the form of money, stock or any other consideration, shall be shared by the parties proportionally to their respective interests.

2. The parties shall share proportionally to their respective interest in any damages awarded as a result of any infringement of any patents granted for said invention.

3. A party's interest shall survive the party's death and shall be disposed of by will or under applicable laws of

intestate succession.

4. Except as provided in paragraph 3 above, no party shall transfer his undivided interest or any portion thereof without the prior written consent of the other party.

5. Any party who grants a license under his interest in the Property to a third party shall promptly provide the other party with a copy of the license agreement.
