WHEREAS, I, William P. Moore

have invented certain new and useful improvements in Palatable
Anionic Feed Mineral Concentrate for which

I make application for LETTERS PATENT OF THE

UNITED STATES, which application has been duly executed by me

AND WHEREAS, Agri-Nutrients Technology Group, Inc, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Virginia, hereinafter called the Assignee, is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention within the United States of America and its territorial possessions and all foreign countries and any United States or foreign LETTERS PATENT that may be granted therefor.

And I do hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents, U. S. A., to issue said LETTERS PATENT, when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

In further consideration of said sum of one Dollar, and said other good and valuable consideration, to me paid, I covenant and agree with the Assignee that I have a full and unincumbered title to the invention hereby assigned, which title I warrant unto the Assignee, and I further agree that I will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request but at the expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining, sustaining, or reissuing United States and foreign LETTERS PATENT for the said invention, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to said invention and LETTERS PATENT particularly in cases of interference and litigation.
