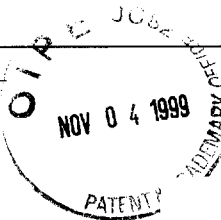

PATENT ASSIGNMENT

In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, **C-A Liquidating Royalty Trust**, a liquidating trust established in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, having a principal place of business at 60 State Street, 20th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02109 ("Assignor"), the sole and exclusive owner (see the following Assignments recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office: Assignment from Clamp-All Corp. to Boston International Associates, Inc., recorded on August 12, 1991, under Reel 5797, Frame 0888; and Assignment from Boston International Associates, Inc. to C-A Liquidating Royalty Trust, recorded on August 12, 1991, Reel 5799, Frame 0595) of the U.S. and foreign patents listed in Exhibit A attached hereto and hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof (collectively the "Patents"), does hereby sell, assign and transfer to **Clamp-All Corp.**, a corporation of the state of Delaware, having a principal place of business at 41 Rogers Road, Haverhill, Massachusetts 01830, and its successors and assigns ("Assignee"), the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and all divisional, continuing, substitute, renewal, reissue and all other applications for letters patent which have been or shall be filed in the United States and all foreign countries on any of the inventions covered thereby; and in and to all original and reissued patents which have been or shall be issued in the United States and all foreign countries on said inventions, including the right to apply for patent rights in each foreign country and all rights to priority.

Assignor agrees that Assignee may apply for and receive Letters Patent for said inventions in its own name; and when requested without charge to, but at the expense of Assignee, agrees to carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this Assignment. Assignor will communicate to Assignee all facts known to Assignor relating to said inventions and the history thereof; and generally do everything possible which Assignee shall consider desirable for aiding in securing and maintaining proper patent protection for

said inventions, in Assignee. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Assignor shall at all times hereafter, promptly upon request by Assignee, execute such assignments of the Patents in countries outside the United States and documents and instruments ancillary thereto as Assignee may request from time to time.


Assignor hereby requests the Honorable Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and the foreign equivalents to issue or transfer the Patents to Assignee.

Assignor covenants with Assignee that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the rights and property herein conveyed has been made to others by Assignor, and that full right to convey the same as herein expressed is possessed by Assignor.

The rights granted to Assignee hereunder shall include, without limitation, the right to recover for past, present and future infringement or other wrongful use or misappropriation of the Patents.
