

ASSIGNMENT

Stanislav Ivanovich Samoylenko (deceased), whose post office address was Ostrovityanova Street 33, Apartment 75, Moscow 117279, Russia, has invented certain new and useful improvements in computer software and hardware for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States entitled:

ADAPTIVE UNIVERSAL MULTIPLE ACCESS

(Attorney Docket No. 6575/53942), United States Serial No. _____ (Patent Application), is being filed on _____.

We, the said inheritors, for purposes of recordation in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, do transfer unto ourselves equal and undivided two-thirds interest, and for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have assigned and do hereby assign to the Norwood Living Trust (Assignee In Part), a revocable living trust in accordance with the laws of California, its successors, assigns (including licensees) and legal representatives, the remaining equal and undivided one-third interest in and to all subject matter invented by Stanislav Ivanovich Samoylenko and disclosed in said Patent Application and in and to all Letters Patent and all convention and Treaty rights of all kinds, in all countries throughout the world, for all such subject matter.

We further authorize and direct our attorneys to insert the serial number and filing date of the Patent Application now identified as Attorney Docket No. 6575/53942 in the space provided above as soon as the same shall have been made known to them by the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

In this instance the signatories shown below are both the assignors and the assignees, through inheritance, inasmuch as Stanislav Ivanovich Samoylenko, the inventor of said Patent Application, husband of Iraida Ivanonvna Samoylenko, and father of Elena Stanislavovna Samoylenko, died August 22, 1998. Per Exhibit A, the signatories below have an equal and exclusive rights to all intellectual property of the deceased.
