## Assignment

This Assignment is entered into and is effective as of 29th August 1995, and is between

BP Exploration Operating Company Limited, a British company of Britannic House, 1 Finsbury Circus, London EC2M 7BA, England (hereinafter BPX), and

The British Petroleum Company p.l.c., a British company of Britannic House, 1 Finsbury Circus, London EC2M 7BA, England (hereinafter BP), and

the Schlumberger Companies being:

Schlumberger Technology Corporation, a company organised under the laws of the State of Texas of 105, Industrial Boulevard, Sugar Land, TX 77478, United States of America (hereinafter STC), and

Schlumberger Canada Limited, a Canadian company of 24th Floor, Monenco Place, 801 6th Avenue, S.W., Calgary, Alberta, Canada T2P 3W2 (hereinafter SCHLUMBERGER CANADA), and

Compagnie des Services Dowell Schlumberger S.A., a French company of 50 avenue Jean Jaures, 92541 Montrouge, France (hereinafter CSDS), and

Sofitech N.V., a Belgian company of Rue de Stalle 140, B-1180 Brussels, Belgium (hereinafter SOFITECH).

WHEREAS Philip Stephen Smith, a British subject of Edificio Alpino, Calle 85, 10-41, Santefe de Bogota, Colombia, and Julie Ann Hibbert, a British Subject of c/o Dr. A. P. Hibbert, Adma Opco, W3, PO Box 303, Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (hereinafter THE INVENTORS) have jointly made an invention relating to "Method for Stabilising Emulsions".

WHEREAS BPX is the Applicant of British Patent Application 9417974.4 filed 7th September 1994, entitled "Method for Stabilising Emulsions" relating to the invention.

- 2. BPX and BP hereby agree that they will sign and will enjoin THE INVENTORS to sign any document, oath, declaration or like paper necessary to give full effect to said Schlumberger Companys' ownership rights relating to the Invention and to Patent Applications and Patents covering the Invention. Said Schlumberger Company agrees to meet all reasonable external expenses incurred by BPX and BP in carrying out their obligations under this clause.
- 3. This Assignment does not form part of a larger transaction or series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceed £30,000 (thirty thousand pounds sterling).
