WHEREAS, We, Benjamin M. Gaston and John F. Hunt, being citizens of the United States of America, are co-inventors of certain new and useful inventions and discoveries, for which We have made an application for Letters Patent entitled "CONDENSATE CALORIMETRIC NITROGEN OXIDE ANALYZER" the specification of which was filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on March 28, 1996, and assigned United States Patent Application Number 08/623,643; and




