

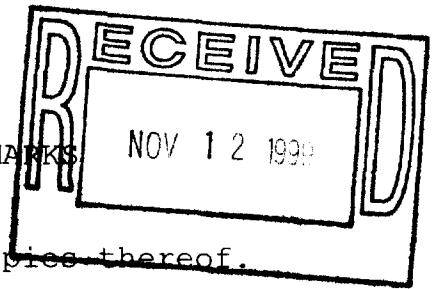

Telephone With Display
