Letters Patent in the United States of America,


an International Patent in which the United States of America is named as a designated State,

And I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue any United States Letters Patent and any and all continuing applications, reissues or extensions thereof in the United States of America to THE GLEASON WORKS as sole Assignee.
