A S S I G N M E N T

WHEREAS, we, Nicholas E. Schnur and Bruce J. Beimesch, residing at 4347 Mount Alverno Road, Cincinnati, OH 45238 and 2499 Woodhill Court #11, Crescent Springs, KY 41017; respectively, have made an invention in: METHOD OF IMPROVING PERFORMANCE OF REFRIGERANT SYSTEMS, and are about to make application for United States Letters Patent therefor, the same being executed by us on the 18 day of August, 1999;
