

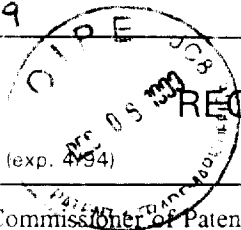

WHEREAS, we, Michael A. KOMARA and Thomas R. SCHMUTZ, both of Indialantic, Florida, Jeffrey W. SMITH of Palm Bay, Florida, and Stephen J. 


