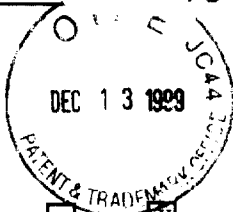

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Dr. Martin Sting, of Oberlindau 77, 60323, Frankfurt, Germany, and Stefan Will, of Hauptstrasse 14, 35444, Biebertal, Germany (hereinafter "Assignors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in CHARGING APPARATUS for which application for a U.S. Letters Patent was made on September 21, 1999 as Serial No. 09/400,426.
