

This is a preliminary proposal to establish a mutually agreeable contractual arrangement for compensation of wiper synchronizer patent(s) as well as ongoing support of electrical engineering needs and application engineering for the synchronizer. The patent(s) is to cover windshield wiper systems generally referred to as air and electric. These systems are generally 12 Volt and 24 Volt powered.

The total compensation for this arrangement is \$275,000. \$17,000 has been paid prior to signing of this agreement, as compensation for development and application activity provided to date. \$158,000 is due as follows \$108,000 within 30 days of transfer of patent(s) pending to Dana, the balance due 30 days after ownership of intellectual property associated with the final patent(s) identified above is transferred to Dana. This is estimated to take approximately 1-2 years based on normal patent processing timing.

An additional \$50,000 annually for two years, (paid in monthly installments in arrears beginning July 1999 inclusive), for activity associated with electrical engineering support and application engineering for wiper synchronizers. This would include current activity on 24-Volt applications with multiple electric motors. Future activity on 12 and 24-Volt applications with multiple electric motors, this would include non-crossing and crossing pattern applications. Additionally, development and application activity is to be completed for windshields wiper systems utilizing more than one air motor.

The annual compensation identified above is to include 20 hours per week (Average) of Electrical Engineering support, as necessary, to facilitate product development and application of current and future activity.
