

A S S I G N M E N T


WHEREAS we, Gerald John Guskey and Curtis Bobby Motley of Montgomery, County of Hamilton, State of Ohio and of West Chester, County of Butler, State of Ohio respectively, have made a certain new and useful invention as set forth in an application for United States Letters Patent entitled Antiperspirant and Deodorant Compositions Containing Cyclohexasiloxane, Attorney's Docket 7555, executed by us, respectively, the 18th day of MAY, 1999, and the 18 day of May, 1999, Serial No. 09/314,795, filed the 18th day of May, 1999 (the hereinafter named assignee being hereby authorized to insert said Serial Number and filing date when ascertained):

We made said invention set forth in said patent application while employed by The Procter & Gamble Company, and acknowledge our obligation at the time the invention was made to assign said invention to The Procter & Gamble Company. The entire right, title and interest shall vest irrevocably in The Procter & Gamble Company. We further agree upon request, without additional compensation but at no expense to us, to execute or assent to foreign applications, and to execute all other legal documents as may be necessary or desirable to vest the enjoyment of the rights assigned to The Procter & Gamble Company, its legal representatives, successors and assigns, or as said Company may direct.

AND we request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any Letters Patent of the United States which may be issued for said invention to said The Procter & Gamble Company, its legal representatives, successors or assigns, as the sole owner of the entire right, title, and interest in said patent and the invention covered thereby.
