ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, Stephen Larghi, resident of Keller, Tarrant County, Texas, citizen of the United States of America, Thomas J. Cook, resident of Vancouver, Clark County, Washington, citizen of the United States of America, Allan D. Angus, resident of Bedford, Tarrant County, Texas, citizen of Canada, and Donna Regenbaum, resident of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas, citizen of the United States of America, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a "SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR CONTROLLING AN END-USER APPLICATION AMONG A PLURALITY OF COMMUNICATION UNITS IN A WIRELESS MESSAGING NETWORK" disclosed in an application for United States Letters Patent (Application No. 09/387,480 filed September 1, 1999), said application having been executed concurrently herewith;

We hereby further agree that we will communicate to said ASSIGNEE, or to its successors, assigns and legal representatives, any facts known to us respecting any improvements; and, at the expense of said ASSIGNEE, to testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all

divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and substitute applications, and make all lawful oaths, and generally do everything possible to vest title in said ASSIGNEE and to aid said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries.
