

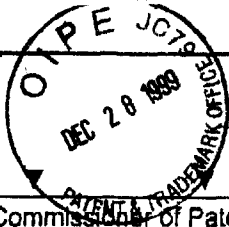

WHEREAS, Donald D. Sheelen and Louise M. Sheelen individuals operating under the laws of the State of Florida, having a principal place of business and mailing address at 1290 Gulf Blvd., Unit 201, Clearwater, Fl. 33767 and which, together with its successors and assigns is hereinafter called "Assignee", is desirous of acquiring the title, rights, benefits and privileges hereinafter recited;

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which Assignor hereby acknowledges, Assignor hereby without reservation:

1. Assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and discoveries in whatsoever countries, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation and Convention applications based in whole or in part upon said inventions and discoveries, or upon said applications, and any and all Letters Patent and reissues and extensions of Letters Patent granted on said inventions and discoveries or upon said applications, and every priority right that is or may be predicated upon or arise from said inventions and discoveries, said application for said Letters Patent;

2. Authorizes Assignee to file patent application in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in the name of Assignee or otherwise;

3. Authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee; as Assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;

4. Warrants that Assignor has not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions and discoveries, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions and discoveries; and that Assignor has good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance;

5. Binds Assignor's heirs, legal representatives and assigns as well as itself, to do, upon Assignee's request and at Assignees expense, but without additional consideration to Assignor or them, all acts reasonably serving to assure that the said inventions and discoveries, the said patent applications and the said Letters Patent shall be held and enjoyed by Assignee as fully and entirely as the same could have been held and enjoyed by Assignor, its heirs, legal representatives and assigns if this assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to Assignee all lawful application documents including petitions specifications, and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers, and lawful affidavits in form and substance as may be requested by Assignee; to communicate to Assignee all facts known to me relating to said inventions and discoveries or the history thereof; and to furnish Assignee with any and all

documents, photographs, models, samples, and other physical exhibits in Assignor's control or in the control of Assignor's heirs, legal representatives or assigns and which may be useful for establishing the acts of Assignor's conceptions, disclosures, and reduction to practice of said inventions and discoveries. Assignor also agrees to provide, at no cost to Assignor, any reasonable information or assistance to Assignee in any infringement actions Assignee shall decide to initiate in order to enforce the patent rights being transferred herein provided, however, all expenses incurred in such infringement actions shall be paid entirely by Assignee.
