PATENT ASSIGNMENT

Assignment made as of August 19, 1999 by and between Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., as successor to First Interstate Bank of California ("Assignor") and Street Scene Manufacturing, Inc., a California corporation ("Assignee").


assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this Assignment and sale not been made, including rights which Assignor now or may in the future own, and all Letters Patent to be obtained on any continuation, division, renewal, substitute or reissue of the Patents and Applications for the full term or terms for which the same may be granted.

Assignor also assigns all of its right, title and interest in and to said Patents and Applications in all foreign countries, and all applications for Letters Patent which may evolve therefrom, including the right to claim International Convention priority.

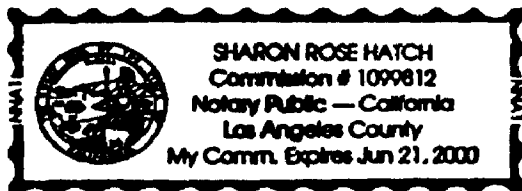
