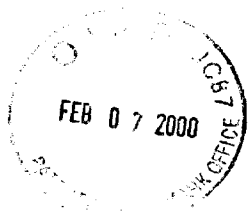



ASSIGNMENT BY JOINT INVENTORS


