UNITED STATES PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment (the "Assignment") is made as of this 6th day of December 1998, by and between Timothy P. Barber, residing at 120 North Mobley Drive, Boise, Idaho, 83712 ("ASSIGNOR") and KEYNETIC SYSTEMS, LLC, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of California, having a place of business at 11931 Chalon Lane, San Diego, CA 92128, ("ASSIGNEE").

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration received by ASSIGNOR from ASSIGNEE, the receipt in full of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. ASSIGNOR hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys unto ASSIGNEE the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and in and to any division, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and extension of said Patents, together with all of ASSIGNOR's entire rights under the International Convention, and all other rights vested in ASSIGNOR by virtue of the instruments of assignment and/or by virtue of other instruments pursuant to which ASSIGNOR became vested with said ownership, including the right, title, and interest in and to any and all improvements acquired pursuant to the terms of said instruments of assignment, and each and every Letters Patent, both foreign and domestic, which is granted on any application which is a division, substitution, continuation or continuation-in-part of the Patents, and in and to each and every reissue or extension of the Patents.
2. ASSIGNOR further sells, assigns, transfers and conveys unto ASSIGNEE the entire right, title and interest in and to any and all causes of action and rights of recovery for past infringement of the Patents.
3. ASSIGNOR hereby covenants and agrees to cooperate with ASSIGNEE so that ASSIGNEE may enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interest herein conveyed. Such cooperation shall include prompt execution of all papers prepared at the expense of ASSIGNEE which are deemed necessary or desirable by ASSIGNEE to perfect in it the right, title and interest herein conveyed and to obtain and maintain Letters Patent in any and all countries.
4. The terms, covenants and provisions of this Assignment shall inure to the benefit of ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and/or legal representatives, and shall be binding upon ASSIGNOR, its successors, assigns and/or other legal representatives.

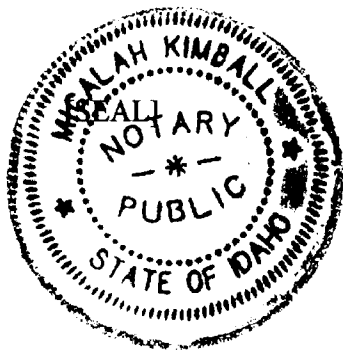
