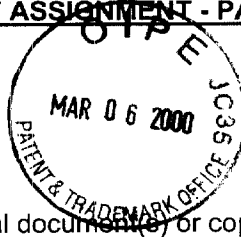

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Edward R. Bass, Konstantin G. Kodonas and Vincent R. Weis have invented certain new and useful improvements in a **INTELLIGENT INTERFACE CABLE ASSEMBLY AND METHOD FOR PROVIDING THE SAME** identified as File Number **E-981** in the Intellectual Property and Technology Law Department files of the hereinafter-mentioned assignee, and for which an application for United States Patent has been filed on December 31, 1999 under serial number 09/476,617;
