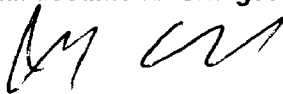

**RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN
AND REASSIGNMENT OF U.S. AND FOREIGN PATENTS
AND PATENT APPLICATIONS**

This **RELEASE AND REASSIGNMENT** is granted on this 28th day of January 2000, by APPALOOSA MANAGEMENT L.P., as Collateral Agent, with offices at 26 Main Street, 1st Floor, Chatham, New Jersey 07028 (the "Collateral Agent"), to McGHAN MEDICAL CORPORATION, a California corporation, BIOENTERICS CORPORATION, a California corporation, INAMED DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, a California corporation, CUI CORPORATION, a California corporation and BIOPLEXUS CORPORATION, a Nevada corporation, each with offices at 5540 Ekwill Street, Suite D, Santa Barbara, California 93111 (collectively, the "Grantors"), as follows:

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the Grantors have heretofore granted to Santa Barbara Bank & Trust, as Trustee, with offices at 1002 Anacapa Street, Santa Barbara, California 93101 (the "Trustee") a security interest in certain U.S. and foreign issued patents and patent applications, as are more particularly set forth on Schedule A attached hereto (collectively, the "Patents"), to secure the obligations of INAMED Corporation in connection with certain agreements previously entered into between INAMED Corporation and the Trustee, which security interest was recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 26, 1998 at Reel 9556 Frame 0787; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee reassigned and granted to the Collateral Agent a security interest in the Patents to secure the prompt payment, performance and observance of the obligations of the Grantors to the Collateral Agent pursuant to certain agreements, which security interest was recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 26, 1998 at Reel 9580 Frame 0595;

WHEREAS, the Trustee released and reassigned to the Grantors all right, title and interest not reassigned and granted to the Collateral Agent, and such release and reassignment was submitted to the United States Patent and Trademark Office for recordation on November 13, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent wishes to release, restore and reassign all right, title and interest in and to the Patents, whether received from the Grantors or from the Trustee, to the Grantors and to dissolve any and all liens and encumbrances respecting the Patents.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Collateral Agent hereby releases, discharges, quit claims, relinquishes and reassigns to the Grantors any and all right, title and interest in and to the Patents and the security interest in the Patents previously granted to the Collateral Agent by the Grantors or by the Trustee.

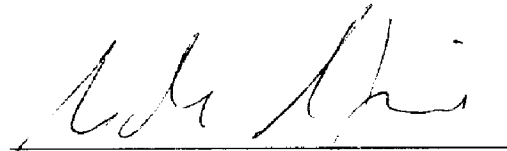
