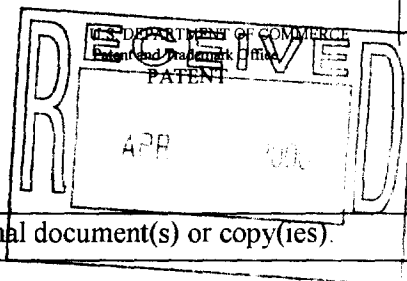

ASSIGNMENT

The undersigned Charles G. Schwab, residing at 28 Hyacinth Drive, Nashua, New Hampshire 03062, has invented a METHOD FOR SETUP AND MOLDING OF FORMED ARTICLES FROM THIN COATED FABRICS and having on the 31st day of JANUARY, 2000, executed an application for United States patent as sole inventor (and I hereby authorize my attorney to prosecute said application and to here insert the filing date and serial number of said application, when known, Ser. No. 09/479,144, filed on the 7th day of January, 2000.) describing the same and based thereon. for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from DIACOM CORPORATION, a New Hampshire corporation having its principal place of business at 5 Howe Drive, Amherst, New Hampshire 03031 hereinafter called Assignee, (which term shall include its successors and assigns) does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto Assignee my entire right, title, and interest as inventor, in and throughout the United States of America (including its territories and dependencies) and all countries foreign thereto, in and to and under said application (which term shall include hereinafter where the context so admits all divisional, continuing, reissue and other patent applications based thereon) and the inventions (which term shall include each and every such invention, or any part thereof) therein described, and any and all patents and like rights of exclusion (including extensions thereof) of any country which may be granted on or for said inventions or on said application;

And for the same consideration I do also hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Assignee all of my rights under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and all other treaties of like purpose in respect of said inventions and said application and I do hereby authorize Assignee to apply in my name or its own name for patents and like rights of exclusion on or for said inventions in all countries, claiming (if Assignee so desires) the priority of the filing date of said application under the provisions of said Convention or any such other treaty;

And for the same consideration I do hereby agree for myself, and my heirs, executors and administrators, promptly upon request of the Assignee, to execute and deliver without further compensation any power of attorney, assignment, original, divisional, continuing, reissue or other application or applications for patent or patents or like rights of exclusion for any country, or other lawful documents and any further assurances that may be deemed necessary or desirable by Assignee to fully to secure to it said right, title, and interest as aforesaid in and to said inventions, application, and said several patents and like rights of exclusion, or any of them, all, however, at the expense of Assignee;

And I do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America and corresponding Officer of each country foreign thereto to issue to the Assignee any and all patents and like rights of exclusion which may be granted in any country upon said application or on or for said inventions;

And I do hereby covenant for myself and my legal representatives and agree with Assignee that I have granted no right or license to make, use or sell said inventions to anyone except the Assignee, that prior to the execution of this deed my right, title and interest in and to said inventions as the inventor has not been otherwise encumbered, and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict herewith.


