

POYNOR**, a citizen of the United States residing at 4195 Kimberly Lane, Oceanside, California 92056, ASSIGNORS, are the inventors of the invention in **GOLF CLUB HEAD WITH A HIGH COEFFICIENT OF RESTITUTION** for which we have executed an application for a Patent of the United States, identified by Pennie & Edmonds LLP docket no. 174-848; and
