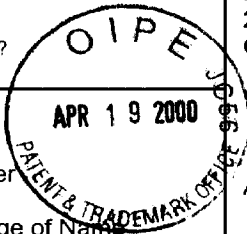

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, MICHAEL D. DUNBAR (“DUNBAR”) and **VINCENT J. VOHNOUT** (“VOHNOUT”), citizens of the **UNITED STATES** residing in **Fredericktown** and **Columbus, Ohio**, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a “**Method For Wrapping Silverware In A Napkin**” for which **U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/097,847** was filed **July 26, 1993** on which **U.S. Patent No. 5,469,688** was issued on **November 28, 1995**, and for which **Australian Application No. 199534137** was filed (as **PCT/US95/10735**) on **August 23, 1995**, on which **Australian Patent No. 700874** was issued;

WHEREAS, VOHNOUT, has, by way of an **Assignment** recorded in the **U.S. PATENT & TRADEMARK OFFICE** on **July 26, 1993** at **Reel 6660, Frame 101**, assigned all his right, title and interest in the aforesaid invention, and any patents granted thereon, to **DUNBAR**;

AND I HEREBY authorize and request the **COMMISSIONER OF PATENTS AND TRADEMARKS** or any other proper officer or agency of any country to issue all said **Letters Patent** to said assignee;

AND I HEREBY warrant and covenant that I have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument or assignment in conflict herewith;

AND I HEREBY agree to communicate to the assignee or its representatives any facts known to me respecting said invention, to execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, and foreign applications, sign all lawful documents and make all rightful oaths relating to said invention, and to testify in any judicial or administrative proceeding and generally do everything possible to aid the assignee to obtain and enforce said Letters Patent in the UNITED STATES or any foreign country when requested so to by the assignee.
