WHEREAS, LYNNTech, INC., 7610 Eastmark Drive, Suite 105, College Station, Texas 77840, hereinafter referred to as Assignor, did obtain a United States Patent No. 5,770,033 having an issue date of June 23, 1998 and entitled:

**METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR USING GAS AND LIQUID PHASE CATHODIC
DEPOLARIZERS HAVING AN IONICALLY CONDUCTING
MEMBRANE ELECTROLYTE; and**

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole owner of the patent; and

Invention; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said Invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said Invention and any application therefor and any Patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions.

3. The term and covenants of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Assignor, their respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

4. Assignor does hereby warrant and represent that it has not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.

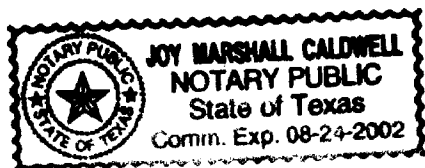
