ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Gerald P. Kelton, Mark E. Hoyack and Timothy J. Olson (hereinafter termed "Inventors"), residents respectively of Tucson, State of Arizona, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a **HYDROCYCLONE AND METHOD FOR LIQUID - SOLID SEPARATION AND CLASSIFICATION** and have executed concurrently herewith an application for a United States patent disclosing and identifying the invention; and

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and

shall be binding upon said Inventors, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

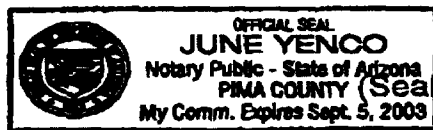

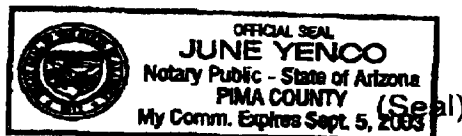
