WHEREAS, we, Lennart Mathe, a citizen of Sweden, residing at 6755 Mira Mesa Boulevard, San Diego, California 92121, Don Kimball, a citizen of the United States, residing at 12880 Orangeburg Avenue, San Diego, California 92129-3511, Joe Archambault, a citizen of the United States, residing at 10540 Mathieson Street, San Diego, California 92129, and Walter Haley, a citizen of the United States, residing at 2110 Dogwood Place, Escondido, California 92026, (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNORS"), have invented and own a certain invention entitled Apparatus and Method for Efficiently Amplifying Wideband Envelope Signals, and have executed an application for a United States patent disclosing and identifying the invention, which application is being filed herewith and not yet assigned a U.S. serial number; and
