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

## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Gerald C. Persha, residing at 12646 Grand River Drive, Post Office Box 214, Lowell, Michigan 49331, respectively (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), has invented certain new and useful improvements in TEMPERATURE COMPENSATING FOCUSER FOR TELESCOPE for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.




