WHEREAS, We, Joseph L. Levasseur and Mark H. Leib (hereinafter ASSIGNORS), are both United States citizens and have invented new and useful improvements in a bill validator having bill detection device for which we have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States, the application being entitled BILL VALIDATOR HAVING BILL DETECTION DEVICE and having been filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) on April 20, 2000, and having been assigned Serial No. 09/553,194 by the USPTO, and being further identified as Haverstock, Garrett & Roberts LLP Docket Number 3567;
