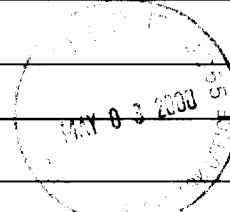

AND HAMEL DAVIDSON INTERNATIONAL INC. hereby covenants and agrees for itself, its heirs, executors and assigns to do all such things and to execute without further consideration such lawful documents, assurances, applications, and other instruments as may reasonably be required to obtain Letters Patent for the said invention and for additions and modification thereto in any and all countries, and to vest title thereto to **SAMSYS INCORPORATED**, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees.

AND HAMEL DAVIDSON INTERNATIONAL INC. authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents to issue said Letters Patent to said **SAMSYS INCORPORATED**, the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for its sole use and benefit, and the use and benefit of its successors and assigns, to the full end of the term for which Letters Patents may be granted. **HAMEL DAVIDSON INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION** hereby covenants that it has the full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that they have not executed, and will not execute, any agreements inconsistent herewith.
