PATENT ASSIGNMENT

ASSIGNMENT entered into effective the 31st day of October, 1995 by and between Westwood Chemical Corporation ("WESTWOOD") a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, located and having a place of business at 46 Tower Drive, Middletown, New York 10940, and Rocco Giovanniello, an individual residing at 8 Painted Apron Terrace, Port Jervis, NY 12771 and Nelson P. Ayala, an individual residing at 33 Euclid Avenue, Middletown, NY 10940 (hereinafter collectively "Employees");

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, on October 31, 1995, United States Patent Number 5,463,098, entitled CLEAR ANTIPERSPIRANT GEL STICK AND METHOD FOR MAKING SAME ("the PATENT") issued to Employees jointly; and

WHEREAS, Employees are employed by WESTWOOD and are obligated under their respective employment agreements with WESTWOOD to assign to WESTWOOD all inventions made during the course of their employment; and

WHEREAS, the invention disclosed and claimed in the PATENT was made by Employees during the course of their employment with WESTWOOD and Employees acknowledge a preexisting duty to assign the PATENT to WESTWOOD;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Employees hereby agree as follows:

1. Employees do hereby sell, assign, and transfer to WESTWOOD, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, hereinafter referred to collectively as ASSIGNEE, their entire, right, title and interest in and to the PATENT for its own use as well as their entire right, title and interest in the invention or improvement disclosed in the PATENT in the United States and all foreign countries and to all patents and patent applications covering same together with all rights of priority created by the application underlying the PATENT under provisions of international conventions or treaties.

2. Employees agree upon the request of ASSIGNEE to execute any and all applications for and documents relating to obtaining patents and the prosecution thereof for said invention or improvement, and any continuations of such applications or substitutes therefor or registrations thereof, and any specific separate assignment of any of the above required for recording in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and any foreign patent office that ASSIGNEE may deem necessary or expedient.

3. Employees agree that in the event of any application based on said invention or improvement, or patent issued thereon, or any reissue or application for reissue thereof, becoming involved in priority of invention proceedings, Employees will cooperate with ASSIGNEE to the best of their ability in the matter of preparing and executing all documents and giving and producing evidence in support thereof.

4. Employees agree to perform upon ASSIGNEE'S request, in writing any and all affirmative acts to obtain United States and foreign patents covering said invention or improvement and to vest all rights in and to the same hereby conveyed to ASSIGNEE, as fully and as entirely as the same have been held and enjoyed by Employees if this assignment and vesting were made.
