WHEREAS, Atlas Roofing Corporation, a Mississippi corporation (the "Assignor"), holds rights in Letters Patent of the United States as set forth on **Schedule A** (the "Patents");

WHEREAS, the Assignor is the sole owner or a licensee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and the inventions which are the subject matter thereof;

WHEREAS, the Assignor has entered into a Loan and Security Agreement dated as of March 22, 2000 (as amended, modified, supplemented and restated from time to time, the "Loan Agreement"; unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized terms are used herein as defined in the Loan Agreement), between the Assignor and certain of its Affiliates, the Lenders, the Documentation Agent, the Syndication Agent and Fleet Capital Corporation, as administrative agent for the Lenders (the "Administrative Agent"), pursuant to which the Lenders have, on the date hereof, made or agreed to make certain loans to the Assignor and may, from time to time hereafter, make additional loans to the Assignor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Loan Agreement the Assignor has agreed to assign and grant to the Administrative Agent, on behalf of the Lenders, a continuing security interest in, and a continuing lien on, all of the Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the following (collectively, the "Patent Collateral"):

- (i) any and all Patents and patent applications,
- (ii) inventions and improvements described and claimed therein,
- (iii) reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof,
- (iv) income, royalties, damages, claims and payments now or hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect thereto, including, without limitation, damages and payments for past and future infringements thereof,
- (v) rights to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, and
- (vi) all rights corresponding to any of the foregoing throughout the world.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor does hereby grant to the Administrative Agent, on behalf of the Lenders, a continuing security interest in and a continuing lien on the Patent Collateral as security for the payment and performance of the Secured Obligations.

The Assignor hereby further acknowledges and affirms that the rights and remedies of the Administrative Agent with respect to the assignment of and security interest in and lien upon the Patent Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Loan Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.


