

TAKE NOTICE that Petro-Canada and its wholly owned subsidiaries, 177293 Canada Ltd. (formerly known as Amerada Hess Canada Ltd.) and 676071 Alberta Ltd. (formerly known as Amerada Hess Resources Canada Ltd.) have formed a general partnership known as Petro-Canada Oil and Gas.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that effective January 1, 1997 (the "Effective Date"), each of Petro-Canada, 177293 Canada Ltd. ("177293") and 676071 Alberta Ltd. ("676071") transferred to Petro-Canada Oil and Gas beneficial ownership of substantially all of its onshore assets located in the provinces of British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, the Northwest Territories and the Yukon relating to the upstream oil and gas business involving exploration, development, production and marketing of petroleum substances, including petroleum, natural gas, natural gas liquids, crude bitumen and all related hydrocarbons and other substances produced therewith, together with its interests in the facilities for processing, transmission, treating, storing and selling such production.

As of the Effective Date, Petro-Canada Oil and Gas assumed all of the rights, duties, liabilities and obligations of Petro-Canada, 177293 and 676071 (collectively the "Partners") pertaining to any lands, assets, contracts, agreements or any other interests whatsoever relating to the beneficial ownership in the assets transferred to Petro-Canada Oil and Gas.


Any necessary and appropriate assignments, novations and notices relating to the assigned assets are under preparation and will be circulated in the near future. Where possible Petro-Canada Oil and Gas will become the registered owner of the assets contributed to the partnership however; for those assets which cannot be registered in the name of Petro-Canada Oil and Gas, registered title will over time be put into the name of Petro-Canada in trust for Petro-Canada Oil and Gas. As noted above, beneficial interest will reside in Petro-Canada Oil and Gas.

All further notices, correspondence, payments and invoices previously addressed to the Partners should now be addressed and sent to Petro-Canada Oil and Gas at the same address in effect immediately prior to the Effective Date. In circumstances where agreements specify notices are to be addressed to the attention of certain departments, positions or individuals, such identification should continue to be used.




