

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT


WHEREAS, pursuant to an Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement dated January 29, 1999, between Newport Acquisition Company No. 1, LLC, and Power Technology, Inc., the ownership of U.S. Patent No. 4,992,920 titled "Regulated AC Power System Energized by Variable Speed Prime Mover" and dated February 12, 1991 (the "Patent"), was transferred from the then assignee of record Power Technology, Inc. to Newport Acquisition Company No. 1, LLC; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and other good and valuable consideration, Newport Acquisition Company No. 1, LLC by these presents does sell, assign and transfer unto said Assignee (Power Technology, Inc.) the entire right, title and interest in and to the said Patent aforesaid; the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee for its own use and behoof, and for its legal representatives and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Patent is granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Newport Acquisition Company No. 1, LLC had this assignment and sale not been made.

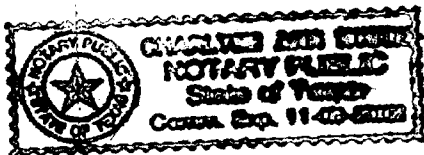
