WHEREAS, Applied Biotech Products, Inc., a Louisiana corporation domiciled in the Parish of Lafayette, (hereinafter referred to as "Applied Biotech"), is the owner of a new and useful "Transcutaneous Intravenous Illuminator", through assignment from Venoscope Ltd, who acquired the rights from the inventor, Kim Landry, which is disclosed and claimed in U.S. Patent No. 4,619,249, issued on October 28, 1986, and reissued as Reissue Patent Re 033,234, on June 19, 1990, both entitled "Transcutaneous Intravenous Illuminator", the assignment from Venoscope Ltd. to Applied Biotech Products, Inc., recorded at Reel 5038, Frame 315 in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office; and

WHEREAS, Applied Biotech is the owner of a new and useful "Instrument for Viewing Subcutaneous Venous Structures", through assignment from the inventor, Frank Creaghan, resident of 204 Louie Drive, Lafayette, Louisiana 70503, which is disclosed and claimed in U.S. Design Patent No. Des 362,910, issued on April 21, 1994, entitled "Instrument for Viewing Subcutaneous Venous Structures", the assignment recorded at Reel 7732, Frame 0865 in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office; and

WHEREAS, Frank C. Creaghan, Jr., an individual who address is 204 Louie Drive, Lafayette, LA 70503, (hereinafter referred to as "Creaghan"), is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and in and to said letters patent that have been granted thereof in the United States and any and all foreign countries;

Applied Biotech hereby authorizes and requests the Patent Office officials in the United States and any and all foreign countries to issue any and all of said Letters Patent, when granted, to Frank Creaghan, Jr. as the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for the sole use and enjoyment of said Creaghan, its successors and assigns.

Further, Applied Biotech agrees that it will communicate to Creaghan or his representatives, any facts known to it respecting said letters Patent, and testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisions, continuations, substitutions, reexaminations, renewal and reissue applications, execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letters Patent to be issued to Creaghan, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything necessary or desirable to aid said Creaghan, his successors or assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.


