ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, PHILLIP E. SCHLANGEN, am the sole inventor of WHEELCHAIRS WITH VERTICALLY ADJUSTABLE SEATS and U.S. Patent Applications Serial No. 29/094,171 filed September 28, 1998 and Serial No. 29/120,695 filed March 27, 2000.

WHEREAS, KURT MANUFACTURING COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Minnesota and having a principal place of business at 1325 Quincy Street Northeast, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55413 hereinafter referred to as "Corporation," is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions for the United States and for all foreign countries, U.S. Patent Application Serial Nos. 29/094,171 and 29/120,695 and in and to any and all foreign and domestic Letters Patents which may be granted therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, To All Whom It May Concern, Be It Known, that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration to me in hand paid, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, I have sold, assigned, transferred and set over and by these presents do sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Corporation, its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and the entire right, title and interest in, U.S. Patent Application Serial Nos. 29/094,171, and 29/120,695 and to any and all Letters Patents of the United States and any foreign countries which may be granted therefor, including my rights under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, and in and to any and all extensions, divisions or reissues of said Letters Patents that may be granted, the same to be held and enjoyed by Corporation for its own use and behoof and use and behoof of its successors and assigns to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patents may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me had this assignment and sale not been made;

AND, for the consideration aforesaid, I materially represent to Corporation, its successors and assigns, that at the time of the execution and delivery of these presents, I am the sole lawful owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the inventions, applications and Letters Patents above mentioned, and that the same are unencumbered, and that I have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in the manner herein set forth;

AND, for the consideration aforesaid, I hereby covenant and agree to and with Corporation, its successors and assigns, that whenever its counsel or the counsel of its successors or assigns, learned in the law, shall advise that an amendment or division of, or any continuation-in-part thereof, or any other proceeding in connection with the filing or prosecution of said domestic or foreign patent applications, including interference proceedings, is lawful and desirable, or that a reissue or extension of said Letters Patents is lawful and desirable, I, or my executors, administrators or assigns will sign all papers and drawings, take all rightful oaths, and do all acts necessary or required to be done for the procurement of valid Letters Patents for said invention, or for the reissue or extension of the same, without charge to Corporation, its successors or assigns, but at

Corporation's expense.

I hereby request the Honorable Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue the Letters Patents to Corporation in accordance with this instrument.
