WHEREAS, We, Thomas S. Nishihira, David A. Blau, and John R. Baldwin, are citizens of the United States of America, residing respectively at 38203 Aralia Drive, Newark, CA 94560, 23005 Standing Oak Ct., Cupertino, CA 95014, AND 8 Botsford Lane, Newton, CT 06470, and (hereinafter ASSIGNORS), have made a certain invention entitled APPARATUS AND METHOD FOR LIMITING LEAKAGE TO GROUND CURRENT WHILE OPTIMIZING OUTPUT OF A POWER SUPPLY ADAPTABLE FOR USE WITH A MOTION SENSOR SWITCH for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States, which application has been assigned Serial No. 09/497,336; and

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree to communicate to said ASSIGNEE, or its legal representatives, successors or assigns, any facts relating to said invention, including evidence for interference purposes or other proceedings, whenever requested, and to testify in any interference or in any other legal proceeding, when requested; and to execute and deliver on request all lawful papers required to make any of the foregoing provisions effective; and to


