



## **ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, I, Darrell R. Finneman of Albany, Oregon, have invented certain improvements in a VEHICLE DISPLAY MONITOR SYSTEM WITH IMPROVED RETENTION SYSTEM ("the invention"), for which I have executed an application for United States Patent on the date I executed this Assignment as hereinafter set forth.



execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of the Patents to be issued to Rosen, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid Rosen, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
