

## ASSIGNMENT

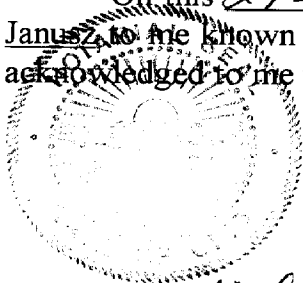
