ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, HAMLIN H. BARNES, 2903 Rams Lane, Fort Collins, Colorado 80526 USA, and FREDRIC ASKHAM, 549 Arrowhead Drive, Loveland, Colorado 80537 USA have invented certain new and useful improvements in "Synthesis of 2-Halobenzyl Alkanoic Acid" for which a patent application was filed on May 8, 2000 as application Serial No. 09/566,953; and
