## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, Michael E. Halleck, resident of Longmont, Weld County, Colorado, citizen of the United States of America, Michael D. Halleck, resident of the Northglenn, Adams County, Colorado, citizen of the United States of America, Gregory V. Halleck, resident of Johnstown, Weld County, Colorado, citizen of the United States of America, and Michael L. Lehrman, resident of Washington, District of Columbia County, District of Columbia, citizen of the United States of America, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a "SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR SEIZING A COMMUNICATION CHANNEL IN A COMMERCIALY AVAILABLE CHILD MONITOR" disclosed in an application for United States Letters Patent (Application No. 09/535,293, filed March 24, 2000).

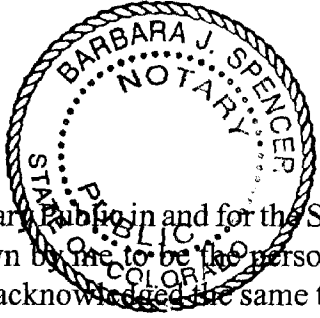
I hereby further agree that I will communicate to said ASSIGNEE, or to its successors, assigns and legal representatives, any facts known to us respecting any improvements; and, at the
