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

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, **MARTIN PINTO**, a citizen of Argentina, residing at 2320 Rising Glen Way, #202, Carlsbad, CA 92008, **STUART SMEDLEY**, a citizen of the United Kingdom, residing at 241 Camino Del Postigo, Escondido, CA 92029, **JEFFREY A. COLBORN**, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 2015 Edinburg Avenue, Cardiff-by-the-Sea, CA 92007, and **JAMES W. EVANS**, a citizen of the United States, residing at 530 Boulevard Way, Piedmont, CA 94610, have made new and useful improvements in **ELECTROLYZER AND METHOD FOR USING THE SAME**, for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on May 16, 2000, as Application No. **09/573,438**.

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our name or in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise.

3. Authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct.

4. Warrant that we have not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, applications, or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use, or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that we have good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance.

5. 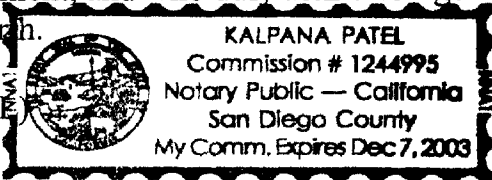

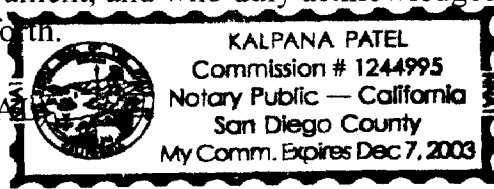

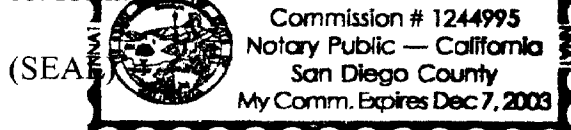
