RELEASE OF SECURITY ASSIGNMENT
(Patents)

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Security Assignment (Patents), dated as of August 13, 1993 and recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on November 4, 1993 at Reel 6748, Frame 0532, as assigned pursuant to an Assignment (Patents), dated as of March 23, 2000 and submitted to the United States Patent and Trademark Office for recording on May 16, 2000 (as so assigned, the "Security Assignment"), VYTECH INDUSTRIES, INCORPORATED, a Delaware corporation (the "Borrower"), has assigned to FLEET CAPITAL CORPORATION, a Rhode Island corporation (the "Lender"), and granted to the Lender, a continuing security interest in, and a continuing lien on, all of the Borrower's right, title and interest in and to the following (collectively, the "Patent Collateral"):

- (a) patents and patent applications, including, without limitation, the patents which are registered in the United States Patent and Trademark Office as set forth on **Schedule A** hereto,
- (b) inventions and improvements described and claimed therein,
- (c) reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof,
- (d) income, royalties, damages, claims and payments now or hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect thereto, including, without limitation, damages, claims and payments for past or future infringements thereof,
- (e) rights to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof,
- (f) patents, patent applications and any other rights corresponding thereto throughout the world, and
- (g) all proceeds of and accessions to any and all of the foregoing;

WHEREAS, the assignment and grant to the Lender of the lien and security interest in all of the Borrower's right, title and interest in and to the Patent Collateral pursuant to the Security Assignment secure the payment and performance of the Secured Obligations, as defined in the Loan and Security Agreement dated as of August 13, 1993 between the Borrower and the Grantor, as amended to date and as may be further amended, supplemented, restated, or otherwise modified from time to time (the "Loan Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, in connection with the termination of the Loan Agreement and the payment in full of all Secured Obligations, the Lender now agrees to release the collateral assignment and security interest with respect to the Patent Collateral evidenced in the Security Assignment on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Lender does hereby agree as follows:

Section 1. Release of Security in Patents. The Lender hereby releases to Borrower without recourse, representation or warranty of any kind (except as provided in Section 2 hereof) all of Lender's rights, title, and interests in the Patent Collateral.

Section 2. Representations. The Lender hereby represents to the Borrower that the Lender has not assigned its interest in the Patent Collateral and that the Lender has all due authority to enter into this Agreement and perform its terms.

Section 3. Binding Effects; Benefits. This Agreement shall be binding upon the Lender and its successors and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of the Borrower and its successors and assigns.

Section 4. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Georgia.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Lender has caused this agreement to be duly executed by its authorized officer or agent as of May 25, 2000.
