# INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

THIS INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT, made by Robert G.

Harrison, and Robert D. Lamson, both of Seattle, Washington (hereinafter "Assignors")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Assignors are joint inventors of a certain new and useful invention entitled APPLIANCES WITH MULTIPLE MODES OF OPERATION which is described and claimed in an application for United States Letters Patent filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on January 5, 2000 under serial No. 09/479,274 (hereinafter "Intellectual Property"); and



Any such assistance shall be provided by the Assignors without additional compensation, but will be at Assignee's expense.


