## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Moore Diversified Products, Inc., a Kentucky corporation ("Corporation") and Moore DP, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("MDP") have entered into a Contribution Agreement dated as of the 28th day of July, 2000 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which Corporation agreed to contribute to MDP substantially all of the assets of Corporation in exchange for specified consideration. NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Corporation does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto MDP all of its right, title and interest in and to the patent application listed in Exhibit A, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the right of priority to file corresponding applications in any and all countries; the patents to be held by MDP for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors and assigns as fully and entirely as they would have been held and enjoyed by Corporation had such assignment not been made.

Corporation hereby authorizes and requests the duly authorized officials of any jurisdiction to take such action as may be required to give effect to the sale, assignment and transfer made herein, including the issuance of the patent application on Exhibit A to MDP, its successors and assigns; and Corporation further agrees to do all things as MDP may reasonably request to effectuate such sale, assignment and transfer in respect to such patent application.

If Corporation owns or has rights to any patents and/or patent applications that are not listed on Exhibit A, Corporation agrees to assign such patents and patent applications to MDP, and Corporation further agrees to do all things as MDP may reasonably request to effectuate such sale, assignment and transfer in respect to each such patent and patent applications.

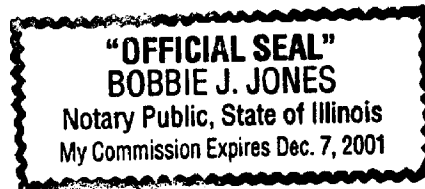
