WITNESSETH:

Whereas, we Stanley Boguszewski and Joseph W. ASSIGNOR hereby warrants that no assignment, sale agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which will conflict with this Assignment.


ASSIGNOR hereby requests the Honorable Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue the Letters Patent of the United States in accordance with this Assignment.




