ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Joseph Samuel Baca and Hermas N. Beaudet (hereinafter termed "Inventors"), residents respectively of the City of Stockton, County of San Joaquin and City of Pacheco, County of Contra Costa, State of California, have invented certain new and useful improvements in **CONDITIONING OIL FOR BOWLING LANES**, and have executed an application for a United States patent disclosing and identifying the invention; and having Serial No. 09/571,494, and filing date of May 15, 2000; and



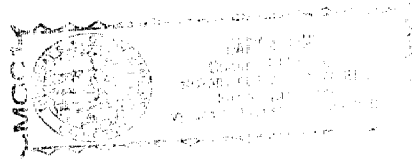

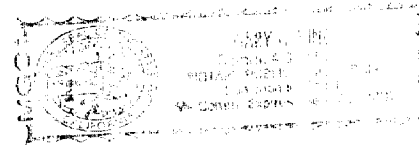
